NEXT STEPS

Step 1: Research programs and zone in on a specific country or city

Step 2: Review your DegreeWorks – farmingdale.edu/registrar/degree-works/

You will be able to determine what courses you still need to take in order to graduate whether they are general education requirements or major requirements

Step 3: Fill out the Preliminary Study Abroad Application farmingdale.edu/academics/centers-institutes/international-education/study-abroad/preliminary-application.shtml

Once this application is submitted a study abroad advisor will contact you and schedule a 30 minute advisement

Step 4: Apply for a passport (passport must be valid for 6 months *after* your planned return date)
