Bob Kahn is an accomplished Grants Professional who previously worked at LaGuardia Community College as their Grants Director. During his tenure, LaGuardia brought in more than \$100 million in grants, the highest among City University of New York community colleges and higher than a number of CUNY four-year colleges. **Bev Kahn**, an FSC Professor, has authored more than \$20 million in grants in her career, including several major institutional grants that have enriched Farmingdale (Title III, Smart Grid, SSS Trio, and First in the World).

Focused on the essentials of preparing strong, competitive grant proposals, this workshop will examine the components of successful grant writing, including:

- finding potential funding sources
- analyzing an RFP (Request for Proposals)
- researching and establishing the need for outside funding
- writing appropriate goals and objectives
- describing the proposed activities and methods
- developing a credible evaluation plan and a realistic budget
- identifying helpful grants-writing resources available online
- addressing the dissemination and sustainability of successful proposals

The workshop is designed for both beginners and intermediate grants writers.
