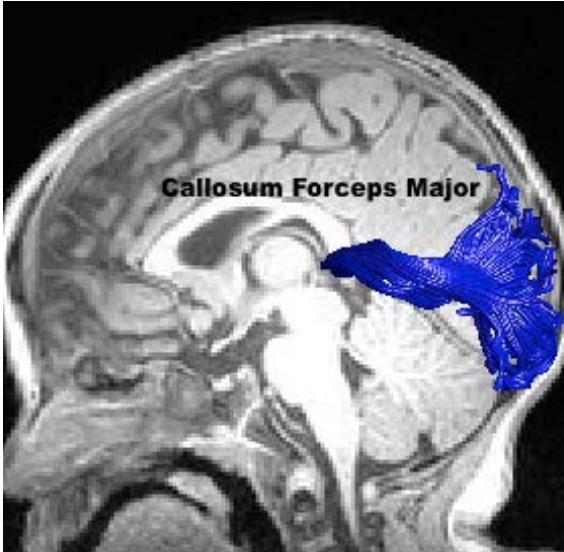

What Makes Someone a Good Reader?

Who struggles? Are there any warning signs? Brain and behavioral evidence from infancy through school-age.

Dr. Figuccio will discuss the predictors of reading development. White matter microstructure is predictive of subsequent pre-reading and reading skills. Additionally, music perceptual abilities predict later reading and spelling skills. Early recognition of children at-risk of reading difficulties will allow for treatment to begin when it is most efficacious.
