"Voices Against Violence" will begin with a one-day tribunal where leaders and citizens from across Long Island can speak to the concerns of our region and offer their input to create potential solutions. In that spirit, this effort will be led by a leadership panel comprised of officials from law enforcement, education, religious institutions, the media, educators, and local and state government. Directions to Campus
