Enhancing Mobility and Internationalization: Intercultural Learning and Teaching Activities from the IEREST Project (in English)

Speakers: Luisa Bavieri and Lucia Livatino (University of Bologna, Italy)

This workshop engages participants in one of the teaching and learning activities devised within the IEREST project. It provides participants with a set of tasks to prepare incoming and outgoing students before, during and after their experience abroad in order to encourage learning mobility and to enable them to benefit from their international experience. The activities aim to introduce participants who teach a diverse student population and students from a multicultural background to key concepts related to identity, such as stereotyping, ethnocentrism, essentializing, and prejudice, and to consider how different types of identities (gender, age, racial, ethnic, national) impact on communication with others. Target audience: Teachers of intercultural communication/education and teachers in charge of student mobility programs; Higher education officers involved in student mobility and internationalization; Members of international associations of teachers and students.
