- Subject line should include: AlumniPopUp_Submission_ArtistName
- Submissions can include up to 5 jpg images
- Work in any media is welcome
- Submissions must include a year of graduation, CV & artist statement
- All files should be labeled with the artist's name and title of work.
- ◦ Ex: Yourname_titleofwork.jpg
- Please submit only completed work, no works-in-progress

- Works older than three years do not qualify
 - Artists will be notified by April 15.
 - All work must be dropped off to the Memorial Gallery:
Monday, May 6 between 10:00AM - 4PM or
Tuesday, May 7 between 12:00 0 7:00 PM
 - All 2D work must be framed,WIRED, and ready to hang
 - No saw tooth hangers.
 - Memorial Gallery staff will not wire or repair work.
 - 3D works must be 40lbs or less
 - Pedestals are available.
 - Pick up of all work:
Friday, May 24 immediately following the reception, artist can remove work from 7-8PM
Monday, May 29 from 10:30 - 3:30 PM
