## About The Leadership Academy

The Leadership Academy at Farmingdale State College enables students to own their lives by developing leadership principles and life skills such as character building, communication, self-awareness, emotional intelligence, problem solving, and conflict management.

## Topics to be covered:

- Creative problem solving
- Defining what leadership is and why it is important
- Effective communication skills: group dynamics
- Team building and vulnerability: adventure ropes course (field trip)
- Discussing social conformity and how it impacts us personally as well as societally
- Personality self-assessment: questioning and exploring self-identity

- Emotional intelligence
- Embracing and discovering who you are and what makes you unique while embracing authenticity
- Conflict resolution/management
- Creative problem solving/seeing aspects from different perspectives
- Gaining confidence through public speaking and group discussion and debates about controversial issues in society
